The Trafficking Victims Protection Reauthorization Act (TVPRA) provides for immigration relief for crime victims, including victims of human trafficking. Immigrants comprise approximately 40 percent of New York City's population, and the existence of T and U visas encourage immigrant victims to report crimes to law enforcement authorities without fear of deportation. This free CLE will provide attorneys and advocates with the tools to assist these crime victims.
